Let me tell you a story about a spiritual growth and renewal opportunity right here in Springfield Ohio. There is a Men's Walk to Emmaus coming up May 30^{th} – June 2^{nd} , 2024, with Rev. Ben Webster and Rev. Ed Fugate as spiritual directors. Guys, here's your chance to get away for a time of fun and growth. There will be a Women's Walk this November 14-17, 2024 with Rev. Beth Cheeseman and I serving as spiritual directors. Ladies, here's you chance to spend quality time with God and with me. Both the Men's and Women's Walks will be held at High Street United Methodist Church.

The Walk to Emmaus relates to the story in Luke 24:13-35; it is a story of two of Jesus' disciples who were walking on the Road to Emmaus. They were heart-broken after Jesus' death. A stranger joined them on the road and opened the meaning of the scriptures for them. At the close of their time together the disciples' eyes were opened as the stranger broke bread and gave it to them. They realized in the breaking of the bread, that the stranger was not a stranger, but Jesus. The point of Emmaus is to open our eyes so that we too may realize that Jesus walks with us as we travel through life, just as he walked the Emmaus Road with his disciples.

The Walk to Emmaus is open to members of any Christian denomination. It is for people who want to strengthen their spiritual lives, get questions of faith answered, develop a better understanding of what Christianity is, and who want a closer walk with Jesus.

The Walk to Emmaus is a 72-hour retreat, with 15 talks (10 lay speaker talks and five clergy talks), special worship services, singing, tons of fun and laughter, great food, snacks, and time to unwind and reflect on your life. The talks present the theme of God's grace, how that grace comes alive in Christian community, and how it is lived our in the world.


