Recently, we withdrew \$15,000 from our investment to help pay the church bills. Regrettably, that withdrawal has been depleted. Two weeks ago, we were told that we will receive \$5,000 from the Lois Stroble estate when it completes probation—whenever that may be?

The General Fund (from which salaries, utilities, and supplies are paid) needs revitalized. Our challenge is TO CONTINUE TO BE A CHURCH THAT HAS THEIR HEART IN THE RIGHT PLACE - WE MUST SUPPORT OUR CHURCH-- BE PRESENT IN THIS COMMUNITY WHERE THE LOST ABOUND - THANK GOD FOR OUR BLESS-INGS AND THEN PASS THEM ON!! WE ARE THE GRACE FAMILY --


